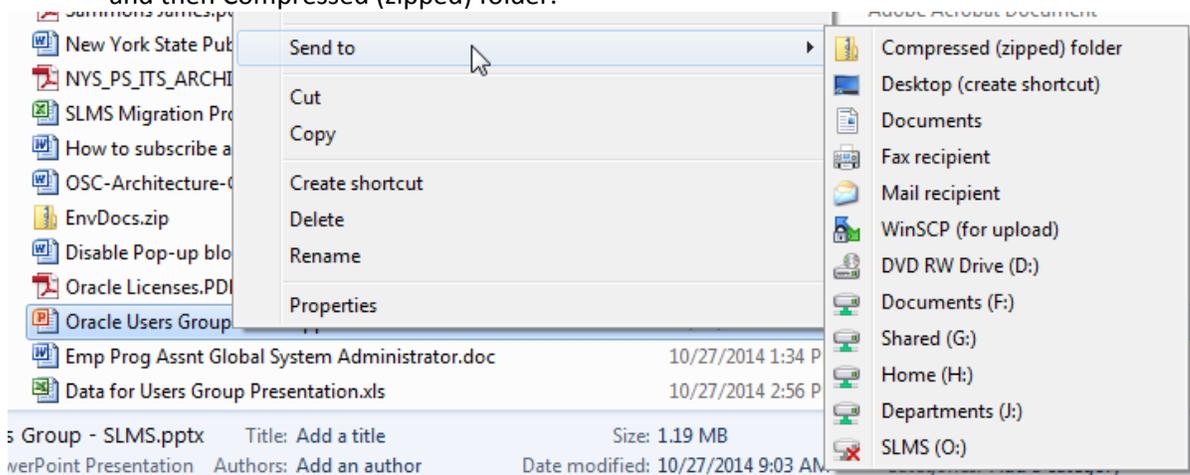
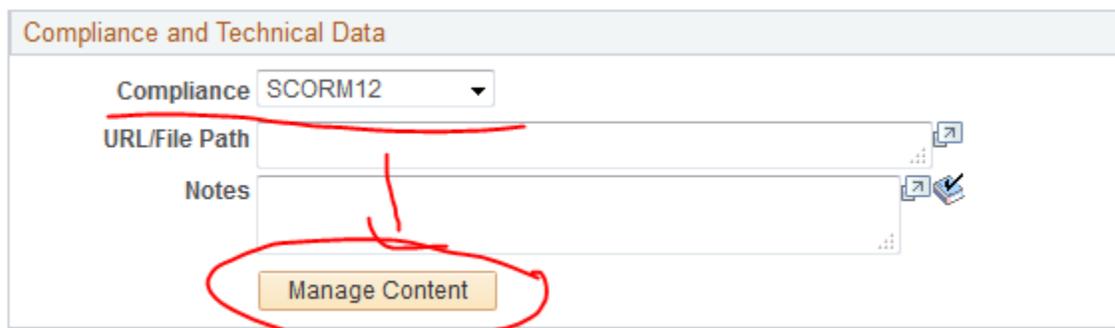


Uploading Non-SCORM Content in SLMS

1. Take your Power Point or PDF file and rename it to remove any spaces (underscores are fine).
2. Zip up your power point file.
 - a. You can do this by right-clicking on the file and then moving your mouse to Send To, and then Compressed (zipped) folder.



3. Once your Power Point/PDF is turned into a .zip file, then rename your .zip file using the naming convention outlined in the SCORM Upload Instructions on the SLMS website (https://nyslearn.ny.gov/documents/SCORM_Upload_Instructions.pdf).
 - a. The file should be named: **SLMS_DFS_xxxxx.zip**.
 - b. After **SLMS_** include your agency acronym (i.e. SLMS_DOT_xxxx.zip, SLMS_OMH_xxxx.zip)
 - c. The xxxxx part is something you can fill in yourself.
4. Now, go to your class in SLMS and go into the Web-Based Learning Component.
5. In the Compliance drop-down menu, choose SCORM12.
6. Then click the Manage Content button.

7. Click the Upload Zip File link
 - a. A dialog box will open and you can browse your desktop to find the .zip file of your power point.
8. Once you have found your file, click the Upload button in SLMS.
9. You will get an error message – you get this message because you are “tricking” SLMS into thinking this is a SCORM compliant file. You can **ignore** this message and click Ok.

10. Once you get the message that says your file was uploaded successfully, then click the Save button.

11. You will get **two more** error messages – you can ignore them.
 - a. Remember, you are tricking SLMS into thinking you are uploading a SCORM compliant file. We do this so that SLMS will unzip the file and place it on both servers.
 - b. Click Ok to ignore both error messages.

12. Click the Return to Previous Page link.
13. Now this is the key part. We've already tricked SLMS into thinking you upload SCORM-compliant content. Now we're going to "un-trick" SLMS.
 - a. **Change the Compliance back to None.**
14. In the URL/File Path field, you need to enter the URL consistent with the examples on the SCORM Upload Instructions document. The first part of the URL is always:
<https://nyslearn.ny.gov/Scorm/>
 - a. The rest of the URL depends on the name of your .zip file **and** the name of your Power Point or PDF file.
 - b. If you named your .zip file **SLMS_DFS_WVP.zip** and your Power Point was named **WVP_GOER_Template.ppt**, then your URL will be:
https://nyslearn.ny.gov/Scorm/DFS/WVP/WVP_GOER_Template.ppt
